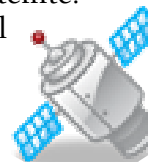

**February 20: “Long-Term Care: Is it a Necessity or a Luxury”** - Bob Petty, Director of Community Education, Alliance on Aging. As people live longer, long-term care becomes more important. This presentation will explain what LTC is, when Medicare covers the costs and the basics of long-term care insurance including how to decide whether this kind of insurance is appropriate for you.

**February 27: “From Sputnik to the Internet and Beyond”** - On October 4, 1957, the Soviet Union surprised most of the world when it launched Sputnik, the first satellite. The US Government created a new agency to make sure that we didn’t fall behind. The Advanced Research Projects Agency (ARPA) later funded much of our modern computer technology research. Among their many projects was the development of the Internet.



Dr. Charles Kline, then a graduate student at UCLA, made the first successful connection between UCLA and Stanford Research Institute which was the precursor to the Internet. He will discuss the history of the Internet from its initial concepts discussed in the early 1960s, development in 1968 and the first transmissions in 1969 leading to where we are today and where we are going from here.
